1. HALTER CLASS – Open to any handler, mini, pony or horse – this class has been split by gender.
 - o Split: Mares
 - o Split: Geldings

A. COLOR CLASS – see below

2. GROOMING CLASS – Open to any handler, mini, pony, or horse – best “turned out/groomed” horse – braiding optional
3. LEADLINE CLASS – Open to any novice rider – all ages
4. SHOWMANSHIP - Open to any handler; pattern will be posted at the show 1 hour prior to show
5. ENGLISH PLEASURE – WALK AND TROT – Open to any rider
6. ENGLISH PLEASURE – WALK, TROT, CANTER – Open to any rider
7. OPEN DRIVING – Any Breed – Singles or Teams – Headers required
8. DRESSAGE SUITABILITY - Open
9. WESTERN PLEASURE – WALK AND JOG – Open to any rider
10. WESTERN PLEASURE – WALK, JOG, LOPE – Open to any rider
11. KHC NATURAL PLEASURE CLASS - Sponsored by KY Horse Council (KHC); Follows Kentucky Horse Council Class Rules
12. TOT WALK/TROT PLEASURE – Western or English – Any rider 10 and under
13. TOT WALK/TROT/LOPE PLEASURE – Western or English – Any rider 10 and under
14. WALK AND FAVORITE GAIT – Any Breed - Western or English – Any rider
15. COMMAND CLASS/SIMON SAYS – Open to any rider, English or Western, must perform commands given by judge. Difficulty increases as elimination is required.

ADDED CLASSES FOR MAY AND SEPTEMBER SHOW:

CLASS 1A: COLOR HALTER CLASS – Open to any breed – any color – any age handler – same rules as Halter Class with emphasis on color

CLASS 16: COUPLES CLASS – A pair of horses/riders must walk side by side and hold hands while executing the commands of the judge (including walk and trot). Safety is emphasized!

CLASS 17: RIDE A BUCK CLASS – Riders perform gaits both way of the ring with a dollar bill under each knee placed by the ring master when the riders enter the arena. If there is a tie, the judge can ask riders to perform a pattern or add difficulty to the maneuvers to eliminate riders. Safety is emphasized! Bareback.

CLASS 18: BOOT SCRAMBLE – Boots are piled in one end of the arena, riders lead their horses to boot pile, find your boots, put your boots on (the correct feet), mount your horse, and race back to the finish line.

CLASS 19: COSTUME CLASS – Ridden or walked in with handler acceptable; please use EXTREME caution as some costumes can be scary to other horses. Please no offensive costumes! Horse must be in costume; handler /rider optional. Special prize added
